## **NEW BIBLE STUDY BY ZOOM**

We are planning to hold bible studies in future weeks by Zoom. Jacki Thomas will be leading the group. Jacki and her husband, Mike, are our Licensed Lay Ministers. A trial will take place next week and our first public session will be on Tuesday, 5<sup>th</sup> May, in the evening. Sessions will be held fortnightly. #### **WEST WINDSOR HUB**



The Hub is going from strength to strength and beginning to settle down. It is taking 60 up to 100 calls a day and referrals are continuing. The Community Wardens are checking on people identified by the government 'shielded' list and ringing us direct if they detect problems

or, they refer individuals to us. So are doctors, paramedics and other agencies.

We have an average of one call a day about free food parcels

The WW Hub is working with other organisations, we are all sharing the food donations with each other - sending it where it's needed:

- Foodshare: Foodshare have increased their support from 50 to 75 families.
- Driven Forward: Driven Forward is supporting 12 homeless people who have been accommodated in shelters.

Local organisations have stepped forward to give valuable support. Many local retail outlets display the Hub poster to help spread the word. The two Hub shoppers, Carolyn Carter and Jackie Holton, are getting sterling support from Tesco, who fast track them to the front of the queue to enter and to check out. Legoland gave a huge amount of food at the start, when funds were low and are still providing help.

## But, WW Hub still needs your food donations, they are always put to good use!

The number of community volunteers has climbed to 61. Some can only help occasionally, but there is now have a great network. This includes amazing people like Adam and Vic. Adam, who does a lot of our church general repairs, will help fix things for isolated people in the community. Vic, who does our church plumbing repairs, will help people sort out plumbing problems. We have other specialists, too, including legal specialists, who will help people with problems.

The Hub continues to look for more funding. The funding site on the All Saints website now stands at just under £2,000 and applications are being made for more grants, including from the Police Property Fund, Shanley Housing and Berkshire Community Foundation. The latter is a joint bid with All Saints Dedworth. We will keep you posted.
