

Our church has received a letter from Jim Tucker, who is Lay Chair of the Windsor and Maidenhead Deanery. He wrote,

The team is still working incredibly hard to deliver help to the growing number of those in need in West Windsor. The on-site team — Carolyn Carter, David Flanagan, Jackie Holton and Carole da Costa man the building 10:00am — 4:00pm every weekday,

including

bank holidays. The shoppers also work on Saturdays. Our phone volunteers man the phone out of hours to ensure no-one who needs help must wait.

Loneliness and mental health continue to be issues. Another 3 lonely people have sought phone friendship this week and we call them as many times as they need, to help ease their loneliness. We salute those volunteers who expend their time and energy doing this.

Some people have mental health issues and need specialist help. As well as Leo, a mental health first aider for the RBWM, we now have Ida, who is a mental health practitioner for Slough Borough Council who can refer people to a crisis team when necessary.

We continue to phone 10 - 15 people a day who are on our database, but from whom we have not heard for a while. Surprisingly, around a third of these do not realise they are entitled to more than the occasional food parcel and we are pleased to enlighten them!

A needy family recently turned to us in desperation and were delighted to provide a big weekly shop for them. They were amazed that this would continue if needed. They were still sad, as they had almost nothing to give their two young children for their birthdays at this time. West Windsor Hub donated £30.00 for each child's birthday and birthday cakes are being prepared and donated by Jennifer Brown. David Flanagan said to them, "We're not try to get you to join anything. We're not trying to force religion down your throat. We just want to help!" What a message that is sending.
