
Gift Aid will automatically be collected if you tick the box and enter your details.

West Windsor Hub



Many thanks to the Berkshire Community Foundation for the generous grant of £5,000 they have given to All Saints and the West Windsor Hub. This money will help many Dedworth and Clewer residents facing increasing difficulties at this time.



GREAT NEWS! Thanks to the brilliant efforts of Peter Norris, assisted by Jackie Wiggins, Sarah Bissell, Wisdom da Costa and the rest of the Hub team, we have just won a grant from Berkshire Community Fund for £5,000. Praise God!

We have now received 1,500 calls in total and have almost 200 people on our database who need our help. We estimate that about 70% of these are elderly. The other 30%

are younger and include both single parents and young families. Many have financial difficulties. Some have recently become unemployed; others are on zero hours contracts with zero hours to work; others are long term unemployed individuals and many whose benefits do not stretch far enough.

Each day at the Hub begins with prayer and thanksgiving for what God is doing. Please continue to pray for us. Matthew 25:40 says "...whatever you did for the least of my brothers and sisters, you did it for me." WWH is providing for several vulnerable families and working closely with Foodshare. who have some 60 families in their care. A homeless man who had to vacate his shelter contacted us on Sunday. On Saturday night, he had slept by the church bins and then called the Hub number as his last resort. He was met at the church, given a hot meal and fortunately, temporary accommodation for the next day was found for him. This was a real answer to prayer!

We are moving into a proactive phase and plan to phone some of the people we have not heard from after their initial contact, to check that they are managing.
