Luke 2 51-52"Jesus went down with his parents and came to Nazareth and was obedient to them...And Jesus increased in wisdom and in years, and in divine and human favour." This is the only clue about Jesus' life before the age of 30 when he began his ministry – which lasted 3 years. So we gather that for most of his life Jesus lived in the ordinary way of those times. He worked; He supported His family; He loved His God. Not only did He grow physically, He also became a bigger person. He grew into a closer relationship with God and in His human friendships and relationships, before He was called to His ministry.

For most of us there will only be very short periods or may be only one, when God will call us out of our regular existence to play a big, significant part in His service. At these times we need to spring into action and follow His lead with all our strength and energy. For the remainder of our time, we should expect to live ordinary lives, doing ordinary things like commuting to work, bringing up children and grandchildren, caring for the elderly without expecting fame or drama - like Jesus in his earlier years. By keeping faith and showing Christian love to those around us, our insignificance at so many stages in our life will still be a time of great service to God.

# **OPENING OUR CHURCH – LATEST NEWS**

Our country is gradually coming out of the Covid lockdown. Our Government is gradually lifting restrictions. Churches must remain closed for communal worship until July, at least, but on June 15th will be *allowed* to open their buildings for private, individual prayer. The PCC have prayed and debated long and hard considering the geography of our church, the continuing risk of Covid virus contagion and the elaborate precautions that would need to be put in place to minimise risks. We have reluctantly decided to err on the side of caution and delay opening the building of the church for a few more weeks until the course of the pandemic becomes clearer. We realise that some of the congregation will be disappointed, feeling in need of experiencing the sanctity of prayer in church, before the altar. We encourage them to be patient and take advantage of the opportunities for prayer outdoors in our church garden.

The service will be led by Carolyn Carter and Revd. Roy will be speaking.







## **CHANGES AFOOT!**



In the light of lockdown restrictions lifting and the changing patterns of our lives, the teleconference service held on Wednesday mornings are to be discontinued. Instead, starting on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, more Bible Study sessions will be held. At the most recent Bible Study session on Tuesday, 9th June, 15 people attended. Led by Ruth Norris, we discussed the passage in Acts 16 v 23-33, where the prison doors open for Paul and Silas. We



are praying about and discussing the exact format, content and structure of the new Bible Study sessions and will announce more details shortly.



Another change reflecting the easing of lockdown is that the Pastoral Care group resume their monthly meetings instead of meeting every two weeks, as they have been for the past 3 months. This is because the majority of our congregation flock are coping and are well and happy. There are a few people who continue to need extra support and we continue to keep a close eye on them and help however possible.

## WEST WINDSOR HUB UPDATE

Here we can see David Flanagan and Carolyn Carter hard at work checking the food stocks and organising deliveries at the back of the church. Pictured also, is Tiia Stephens from Driven



Forward, one of our partner organisations, with which we regularly share food resources and which is now feeding the homeless recently housed by the council.

We are sometimes asked about the difference between Foodshare and The West Windsor Hub. Foodshare is based at the Dedworth Baptist Church and has been established for many years. It currently serves 60

families across West Windsor – a sharp rise since the start of Coronavirus. We exchange foodstuffs regularly with them. They work on a voucher system, giving to needy families, initially for 4 weeks. Foodshare has its own volunteer network delivering food to families in need. West Windsor Hub provides 20 – 25 people with emergency food parcels on a weekly basis and we also top-up with fresh food to give them a more balanced diet. We also refer people to Foodshare. People who phone us are not means tested and there is no time limit to our help. The only questions we ask are whether there is anything else we can do to help them. We offer a befriending service; a prescriptions collection and delivery service; mental health support; advice dealing with practical issues such finding dentists, sorting out blocked pension payments and even fixing washing machines! In addition, Carole Da Costa, a local councillor uses her knowledge of the local network of official organisations to signpost people towards further help. And Legoland, as well as making food donations early in lockdown, have advertised for volunteers to help us from among their furloughed staff! All these organisations are working hard to help the people of West Windsor. It is great to see so many strands of our community come together to help. Please continue to pray for us – this work God is asking us to do is demanding, but also rewarding and is desperately needed by our community.
