

On Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> October, West Windsor Hub celebrated the completion of its 1,000th recorded task since the installation of its computerised task logging system in late March. In addition to the recorded tasks of shopping, medicine delivery and provision of free food parcels, we continue to make phone calls to the lonely and offer advice about sources of help and signpost to the appropriate agencies. Demand is continuing at a brisk rate, and there is a general expectation that demand for the Hub's services will increase as

furloughing ends, and redundancy and unemployment bite.

David Flanagan is now anchoring volunteers and several supporting volunteers are stepping up to cover individual days. Alison Hughes has been with us on Wednesdays for the last 3 months, Ruth Hopwood (another trustee) continues to work hard on Mondays and we still have Simon and Louise Goodison and Andrea Gosztonyi on Fridays. We also see Adele frequently. Carole and Wisdom da Costa (both trustees) fill in the gaps! We have a new volunteer, Fez, who will start at the end of this month. He is photographed



below. In addition, we have Ruth Norris and Debbie Stobart doing a great job supporting the community on the phone. We are also supported by Lucinda McArthur, Mike Smith, Carolyn Carter and Jackie Wiggins, who are trustee members of WWH.
