Christmas Through the Keyhole This year we'll be putting together a special Christmas event for families and the local schools. Please take a look at the Set and Prop List held by Ruth Norris on Sunday to see if you can help by lending some of the things we need to make it happen. Please also pray into the preparations!

Christmas through the keyhole is a multi-sensory, interactive trail for children that gives them a unique experience of the Christmas Story.
