
Come and worship God on Sunday at 9:15 for Holy Communion and I lam with Morning Worship with kids groups!

Church Update:

The PCC (Parish Church Council) met on Monday and discussed amongst other things:

- Employing three part-time members of staff for the café to look towards extending the opening hours to 10am-5pm Monday to Friday and 10am-2pm on Saturday.
- That a youth trip can take place in the Summer to Amplify (previously known as Yellow Braces.)
- Details for the upcoming annual Church (AMP and APCM) meetings—to be held on Sunday IIth May at 4pm.
- To continue developing a comprehensive plan for church growth that addresses all the needs of the we have in one document. The goal is to use this plan as a basis for applying for grants to help cover the associated costs. Some of these areas include:
 - Employment of part-time Families and Children's' worker
 - o Employment of part-time Youth Worker
 - o Replacement of the aging chairs and technology in the hall
 - o Modernisation of the Church Kitchen
 - o General development of the site for the next 50 years
 - Moving the Church in the direction of having net zero emissions—in line with the policy of the Diocese of Oxford.
- The installation of a HIVE system and new radiators in the hall to improve the efficiency of the heating in the Church Centre
